


Tokujin Yoshioka, 2013

Element is an iconic table, an emblem of purity and poetry, perfectly embodying the design vision of Tokujin Yoshioka. Its central support, suspended between two horizontal planes, seems to defy gravity, evoking a balance poised between earth and sky, between past and future. The black cement finish enhances its sculptural strength, transforming its apparent lightness into a material and intense presence. A project of extraordinary engineering complexity, it embodies Desalto's experience and mastery in metal craftsmanship, giving shape to an object where art and technique merge seamlessly.

Table with a load-bearing steel structure, engineered to ensure stability and durability. Tops are available in metal or MDF, offered in lacquered finishes or hand-spatulated textured finishes that impart uniqueness and depth to the surface. The combination of structural solidity and high-quality finishes allows technical performance and aesthetic expression to coexist, maintaining coherence with the project's sculptural language.
